Pursuant to the Rules and Regulations governing the use of pesticides for controlling or eliminating aquatic insects adopted by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation, permission is granted to the permittee or his or her agent(s) pursuant to the provisions Article 15 of Environmental Conservation Law to apply the listed pesticide(s) to the waters identified above located in the town and county identified above in conformance with all statements and agreements set forth in the application.

THIS PERMIT IS ISSUED SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS:

1. THE PERMITTEE MUST NOTIFY THE FOLLOWING PARTIES AT LEAST 48 HOURS PRIOR TO THE PESTICIDE TREATMENT:

NYSDEC, Westchester County Health Dept.

2. Permittee must provide notification of the application as required by Article 33 Section 33-0905 of the ECL as follows:

Option 2

Prior notice of the pesticide applications shall be provided by newspaper publication at least twice; once at least one week in advance of the proposed pesticide applications, and once during the application season. A publication that includes the following will satisfy your notification obligations:

- A. A detailed statement describing the proposed application, the purposes of the application and the sponsor of the application;
- B. The product name, EPA product registration number(s) and common chemical names of the pesticide(s) to be applied, and the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency toxicity category of "danger", "warning" or "caution" for each pesticide to be applied;
- C. The proposed date(s) of the pesticide application(s)
- D. The target pest(s) of the application;
- E. A detailed description and/or map of the specific area(s) to be treated. Specific reference should be made to a map of the specific areas to be treated that is on file in a public office in the municipality where the treatment is to be conducted, as well as the hours during which the map is available for public viewing;
- F. The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation's Regional office telephone number is (845)256-3097. The regional Poison Control Center number is (845)353-1000. And the National Pesticide Telecommunications Network telephone number is (800)858-PEST .
- G. The name, address and telephone number of a contact person located at the project sponsor's place of business and the hours of availability of the contact person, a statement that the contact person will answer questions regarding the proposed pesticide application, a statement that inquiries concerning symptoms of pesticide poisoning for the pesticides of concern should be made to the regional Poison Control Center and, unless the applicator and the sponsor agree otherwise in writing, a statement that the sponsor will be advised of the specific pesticide application date on the calendar day prior to the proposed application and may be contacted to obtain that information.

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3. Upon issuance of this permit, the permittee has accepted expressly, by the execution of the application, the full legal responsibility for all damages, direct or indirect, of whatever nature, and by whomever suffered, arising out of the treatment described herein and has agreed to indemnify and save harmless the State from suits, actions, damages, and costs of every name and description resulting from said treatment.
4. No spray material is to be applied to or allowed to drift into any known potable water sources.
5. If no treatment is made and the permit is not used, notification to this effect must be made to the individual identified in item No. 1 of the conditions of this permit.
6. Application is not authorized within 100 feet of state-regulated wetlands without a separate Article 24 permit. Pursuant to Article 24 of the Environmental Conservation Law of New York State (Freshwater Wetlands Act), application of pesticide conducted pursuant to this permit, in any freshwater wetland or adjacent area, will require an Article 24 Freshwater Wetlands Permit. Additional Restrictions:

Note That:

This permit does not authorize the treatment of water lying on or passing through the property of others without their consent nor relieve the applicant of any legal necessity to obtain such consent before treatment. This permit shall not be construed as conveying to the applicant any right to trespass upon the lands of others to perform the treatment or as authorizing the impairment of any right, title or interest in real or personal property held or vested in a person not a party to the permit.

This permit grants no right to treatment of lands under control of the Department of Environmental Conservation nor relieves the applicant of the responsibility to obtain permission from that Department for any treatment of waters lying under their control, unless a specific signed authorization appears on this permit.

Failure to comply with the permit terms and all New York State Department of Environmental Conservation Laws, Rules, and Regulations subjects the permittee to prosecution under these laws , and will be deemed sufficient reason for denial of future permit applications.
