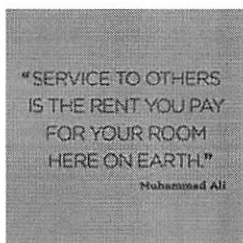

We're using the dunks in our own yard and they seem to be making a huge difference. Thank you for introducing them.

One question I have after reading the FAQ. The e-blast said VOM is using them around Otter Creek, but the FAQ says

However, they should not be used to kill larvae in wetlands connected to Long Island Sound because mosquito larvae are a major food source for marine life in wetlands.

I have total trust in your judgment, but even so, please assure me that the Otter Creek applications are not going into the wetland portion.
